24TH WORLD OZONE DAY

COMPETITION FOR SCHOOL STUDENTS

CONTEXT

The world community realizing the adverse effects including skin cancer, eye cataracts, weakening of immune system and damaging crops and natural eco-systems of depletion of Ozone Layer signed an international treaty, the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer on 16th September, 1987, for phase out of production and consumption of Ozone Depleting Substances (ODSs) responsible for depletion of ozone layer. Since 1987, the Montreal Protocol has successfully phased-out production and consumption of several ODSs and resulted in reducing abundance of ODSs in the stratosphere and put the Ozone Layer on the path of recovery.

The General Assembly of the United Nations vide resolution, 49/114, of December 1994, designated 16 September as the World Ozone Day. Since then, the day has been celebrated in ways that have served to promote national and global efforts to protect the ozone layer.

This World Ozone Day offers an opportunity to focus global attention and action on this vital environmental issue.

To create greater awareness among the students to protect the Ozone Layer, different competitions for the school students are arranged each year with active participation of the schools.

COMPETITIONS

On the occasion of 24th World Ozone Day three different competitions on the theme '**Protection of the Ozone Layer**' for the school students in the age group of 13 to 17 years are being organized. The three categories of the competitions are:

- 1. **Poster Design**: Drawing sheet (3 best entries)
- 2. **Painting**: Drawing sheet (3 best entries)
- 3. Slogan Writing: (3 best entries)

PARTICIPATION OF STUDENTS

The competitions of **Poster Design, Painting and Slogan Writing** will be organized by the respective schools. The best three nominations under each categories of competitions submitted by the schools will be considered by the organizers and the panel of Experts will evaluate and declare the winners under each category.

The last date of submission of entries/nominations at the venue is <u>Friday</u>, 31st August, 2018.

NOMINATION PROCEDURES

Individual competitions for each of the above categories will be organized at the school level by the school authorities through a transparent selection process.

Based on the internal competitions, respective schools should shortlist/select 3 best entries in each categories of Poster Design, Painting and Slogan Writing. The respective participating schools should submit the best three selected entries duly nominated by the school authorities latest by Friday, 31st August, 2018 at the venue.

School should use the enclosed Nomination Form for nominating the entries. The nominated entries of **Posters**, **Painting and Slogans** should have proper label fixed at the back. The **label** must be legible and should contain the following information and preferably it should have the official seal of the school:

BEST ENTRIES AND AWARDS

The best 3 entries of Paintings, Posters, and Slogans received from schools will be evaluated and finalized by a **Panel of Judges.**

Winners of different categories will be intimated by 8th September, 2018 and **Prize/Certificate** will be awarded to the winning students on 14th September, 2018 by the **Chief Guest** of the Function.
